The Orb is a café and a second hand shop. They sell DVD's, clothes, games and books. When I come here I work with my staff. I help run the shop by serving people, making drinks, washing clothes and labelling the stock. I like coming to the Orb.

The Orb is a place where you can get lots of stuff from. You can help people in the orb. You can do laundry. You can sort out good and broken toys for children. The orb is a centre for education and personal development. It has been especially designed to cater for young people and adults with autistic spectrum conditions. - Some people challenge the idea of autism as a disability and see it as no more than a different way of viewing and experiencing the world.
- Autism now affects I in 68 children and I in 42 boys.
- Autism is a 'spectrum condition' which means it can differ a lot from person to person.
- Only 15% of autistic adults in the UK are in full-time paid employment.
- Only 10% of autistic adults receive employment support but 53% say they want it.
- Autism doesn't just affect children. Autistic children grow up to be autistic adults.
